**TURFGRASS OVERSEEDING:** Broadcast 8 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (350 lbs. per acre).

**GROUND COVER:** Broadcast 5 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (½ lb. per 100 sq. ft.).

**SHRUBS & EVERGREENS:** Sprinkle ½ cup evenly around dripline of plant and work into top 1 inch of soil.

**TREES:** Apply ½ lb. per 1 inch of trunk diameter. Distribute evenly under branches out to dripline.

**NOTE:** Liquid measuring cups are very close in estimating the weight of dry granular fertilizers. Example: an 8 oz. (1 cup) measuring cup holds approximately 8 oz. (1/2 lb.) of dry granular fertilizer.

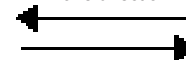
