## Perennial Ryegrass

### FEATURES

### AGRONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- **Admire** has been tested at our sites in Maryland, Ohio, New Jersey, and Idaho since 1997, and has been among the top performers. **Admire** features a medium-fine textured turf with high density and a beautiful green color. **Admire** has outperformed Majesty, Imagine, Palmer II and Affinity in our 1997 Maryland trial.
- Watch for **Admire** in the 1999 NTEP trial. Preliminary results from the site at Virginia Tech place **Admire** among the top 20.
- **Admire** is also one of the components in the MED-007 blend entered in the 1999 NTEP On-Site Overseeding Trial.



### DISEASE & INSECT TOLERANCE

**Admire** was developed under East Coast conditions to provide improved disease resistance to Brown patch, net blotch and leaf spot. **Admire** also has moderate resistance to leaf rust and gray leaf spot.

**INSECT RESISTANCE** **Admire** is enhanced with *Neotyphodium* endophyte to provide resistance to several common turfgrass surface-feeding insects, including:

### USES & SEEDING RATE

**Admire** performs well alone and in blends. It is also adapted to use in mixtures with Kentucky bluegrass and fine fescue in temperate and transition climates. **Admire** is recommended for use on athletic fields, home lawns, industrial and school sites, golf course roughs, tees and fairways where turf-type perennial ryegrass is adapted.

**Admire** is also suitable for winter overseeding of dormant warm-season turf.

**SUGGESTED SEEDING RATES:** Permanent turf establishment 4-7 lbs./1,000 sq.ft.,  
Interseeding: 2-5 lbs./1000 sq.ft.

Dormant bermudagrass overseeding: 200-500 lbs. /acre  
Greens: 25-40 lbs./1000 sq. ft., Fairways:
