## Kentucky Bluegrass

### FEATURES

As a result of its Baron parentage, **Nassau** Kentucky bluegrass (*Poa pratensis*) exhibits many of the fine qualities that have made Baron a popular bluegrass variety, while providing a richer dark green color.

- Maintains a dark green color year-round with minimal fertilization
- Retains its color during fall and winter months
- Excellent drought tolerance
- Produces less thatch than most other Kentucky bluegrass varieties
- Excellent resistance to rust, *Helminthosporium*, and other diseases

### PERFORMANCE CHARACTERISTICS



**A REAL MIXER:** Nassau blends well with other bluegrasses as well as other grass species.

**TOP WINTER AND SPRINGTIME PERFORMANCE:** Nassau retains a beautiful, dark green color in the fall, winter, spring, and summer.
