**PREPLANT:** Broadcast 13.5 lb per 1,000 sq ft (590 lb per acre) cultivate into the top 4-6 in. of soil.

**OVERSEEDING:** Broadcast at 7 lb per 1,000 sq ft (300 lb per acre).

**GROUND COVER:** Broadcast at 6 lb per 1,000 sq ft.

**SHRUBS & EVERGREENS:** Sprinkle 0.25 cup evenly around the dripline of plant and work into top 1 in. of soil.

**CITRUS & AVOCADO TREES:** Make 3 applications per year (Feb - March, June - July, Oct - Nov).

**Mature Trees:** Apply 6 lb around the dripline of the tree.

**Younger Trees:** | 4-6 ft high: 8 oz | 2-4 ft high: 2 oz | Newly planted: 1 tbsps |

**NOTE:** Liquid measuring cups are very close in estimating the weight of dry fertilizers. **E.g.** An 8 oz (1 cup) measuring cup holds approximately 8 oz (0.5 lb) of dry fertilizer.
