IRRIGATE THOROUGHLY IMMEDIATELY AFTER APPLICATION.

PREPLANT: Broadcast 7.5 lb per 1,000 sq ft (325 lb per acre)

GROUNDCOVER: Broadcast at 5 lb per 1,000 sq ft (0.5 lb per 100 sq ft)

SHRUBS & EVERGREENS: Sprinkle 0.25 cup evenly around dripline of plant and work into top 1 in. of soil.

TREES: Apply 0.5 lb per 1 in. of trunk diameter. Distribute evenly under branches out to dripline.

NOT RECOMMENDED FOR NURSERY APPLICATION.

NOTE: Liquid measuring cups are very close in estimating the weight of dry fertilizers. E.g. An 8 oz (1 cup) measuring cup holds approximately 8 oz (0.5 lb) of dry fertilizer.


