- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift. Keep people and pets out of the area during application. Do not allow people or pets to enter the treated area until dusts have settled.
- Do not apply this product to dichondra or carpetgrass. Do not apply this product to 'Floratam' St. Augustinegrass in Florida
- Do not use this product where desirable clovers are present. Do not exceed specified dosages for any area. Apply when the air is calm. Do not apply to newly seeded lawns. During application, close spreader openings when turning to prevent over-application.
- Do not use this product on or near desirable plants, and avoid spreading granules onto exposed root systems or adventitious shoots (rhizomes) within the drip line of desirable trees and shrubs, since injury may result.
- Do not apply directly to or near water, storm drains, gutters, sewers, or drainage ditches. INSTRUCTIONS:

Turf Supreme® 16-6-8 with Trimec® controls a wide range of lawn weeds including dandelion, chickweed, knotweed, plantain, henbit, spurge and many others commonly found in home lawns as listed. In addition, a 16-6-8 fertilizer provides plant nutrients or a supply of plant food. Possible retreatment may be necessary if (a) lawn is heavily overrun by weeds, or (b) if adverse low moisture conditions prevail and weeds are in a state of poor growth. A second application may be made in 30 days.

The maximum broadcast application rate is 5.0 lb of product per 1,000 sq ft per application. The maximum number of broadcast applications is limited to 2 per year with a minimum of 30 days between applications. The maximum seasonal rate is 10.0 lb of product per 1,000 sq ft.

- Mow lawn to normal height 1 to 2 days before application.
- Apply when weeds are young and actively growing, preferably in the morning when dew is on the grass. If grass is not moist at time of application, sprinkle lightly with water to allow the granules to adhere and to remain on the leaf surface of the weeds.
- Do not wash from weed leaves for 1 to 2 days after application. At this time a thorough watering should be made
