TURFGRASS OVERSEEDING: Broadcast 10 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. (436 lb. per acre).

GROUND COVER: Broadcast 7 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. (11 oz. per 100 sq. ft.)

ANNUAL FLOWERS: Preplant 10 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. post plant: 7 to 10 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft.

SHRUBS & EVERGREENS: Sprinkle ½ cup evenly around dripline of plant and work into top 1 inch of soil.

HYDRO SEEDING: For a 2 lb. N-P₂O₅-K₂O rate add 12.5 lb. BEST® ENDURE 16-16-16 with GAL-Xe^{ONE}™ to tank mix per 1000 sq. ft.

NOTE: Liquid measuring cups are very close in estimating the weight of dry granular fertilizers. Example: an 8 oz. (1 cup) measuring cup holds approximately 8 oz. (1/2 lb.) of dry granular fertilizer.

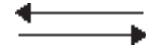
