Missouri Restrictions

- This product can only be applied by air to rice grown in the following Missouri counties principally located in the Missouri boot heel region: Bollinger, Butler, Dunklin, Mississippi, New Madrid, Pemiscot, Ripley, Scott, Stoddard, Wayne.

Texas Restrictions

- This product can ONLY be applied by air to rice in the following Texas counties: Austin, Brazoria, Calhoun, Chambers, Colorado, Fort Bend (North and East of Highway 36), Galveston, Jackson, Jefferson, Lavaca, Liberty, Matagorda, Victoria, Waller, and Wharton.
- This product must only be applied when the potential for drift to adjacent sensitive area (known habitat for endangered species) is minimal (wind is blowing away from sensitive area).
